In maths we are tackling ratio, proportion and scale




factors. Although it sounds a little scary, we've soon discovered that it's just using our multiplication and division skills. This is a great one to do at home as we do it all the time with recipes. A recipe for 6 cakes can be scaled up proportionally to 12 cakes by doubling or even 3 cakes. Ask them to show you an example.
