In English we've started writing up some of our paragraphs for A Trip To London, using subordinate clauses and inverted commas for direct speech.

In maths we've been dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers and learning about how to calculate perimeter and area.

and in Maths we will spending time developing skills in some of the areas children have struggled in.

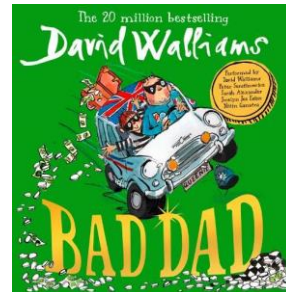
