

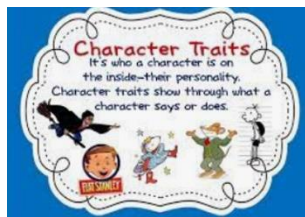


Date: week ending 24th September
