

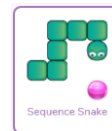

Activity 2 – Use problem solving skills to answer the questions on decimal numbers. Use a place value chart to help if needed.

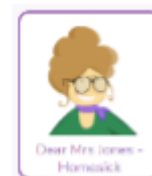


Computing: Focus – Coding. Activity 1 – The Chimp task is to move the turtle and change its direction and move toward its food.
