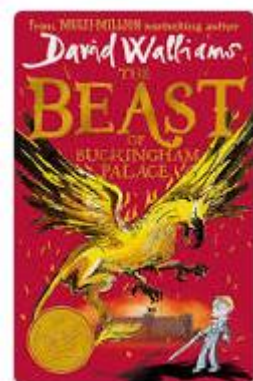


Coming up.....
